I would just like to communicate to all parties that I called Legal Aid and through the automated process, it told me to call the Landlord & Tenant Board. That automated process told me to call Legal Aid. So I called Legal Aid again, but this time I indicated I had a mental health issue. So it directed me to an agent. I told her everything I just stated and she directed me to the Community Legal Clinic (CLC) for Simcoe, Haliburton, & Kawartha Lakes, to get a half-hour of legal advice. I left them a voicemail explaining my situation. This is the second time I've done this process and the CLC doesn't return calls I guess. The first time I received a "half-hour" of free legal advice was through the Law Society Referral Service. And their advice was that I pay them \$1,200.

It appears I'm supposed to represent myself. Mentally, I don't have the strength to keep doing this by myself and with no money. I'm going to launch a Facebook campaign seeking legal help and if nothing comes of that, then I'll file a response to Barrie Housing near the end of the 20-day allotted time frame to respond.
