This letter is further to your request for access to records under the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* (the Act) received on June 29, 2024 for the following:

- This is a request under this jurisdiction's freedom of information legislation for records held by The Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing.

I'm seeking a list of all the property addresses in the Barrie Municipal Non-Profit Housing Corporation (BMNPHC) property portfolio, as well as a list of all the property addresses in the Simcoe County Housing Corporation (SCHC) property portfolio, as of June 29, 2024.

- o For each property, how many one bedroom units are there? Of these, how many are subsidized units?
- o For each property, how many two bedroom units are there? Of these, how many are subsidized units?
- o For each property, how many three bedroom units are there? Of these, how many are subsidized units?
- o For each property, how many four bedroom units are there? Of these, how many are subsidized units?
- o For each property, how many five bedroom units are there? Of these, how many are subsidized units?

Finally, if properties have changed portfolio's between January 2008 and June 2024, we need a list of the properties that changed portfolios, including the date in which the change occurred.

- Time period: From January 01, 2008 to June 29, 2024

7. What are the reasons for your Response, including any facts relied on and representations in support of your Response?

The County supports public access to information and uses its best efforts to comply with its obligations under the Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, 1990.

Mina doesn't bother reading the requests he receives from poor people, just like Alex Nuttall. The respondents do not see poor people as human beings.

Response to alleged harm if interim remedy is denied

1. The harm alleged by Ms. Dyck bears no nexus to the "interim" remedy requested.
2. Ms. Dyck has not made a request for interim relief but has instead requested the Tribunal appoint her to serve in government.
3. The balance of harm to be suffered should the requested remedy be granted weighs heavily against the County and SCHC, as the relief requested is not interim in nature.

Look at how many tax-payer dollars they just wasted on lawyers to give a response that was publicly available online, which they even state. They did not provide the correct information and they still haven't provided the correct information and today's date is Aug. 30, 2024: They lied to the Tribunal when they stated they wish to cooperate. Based on the underlined statements above alone, they wish to do the exact opposite of cooperate. The City of Barrie created a new policy on Aug. 14, 2024 that intends to prevent sharing the above requested information.

The respondents don't want any advantages created for The City of Barrie's and Simcoe County's disadvantaged residents because they don't think we deserve to live.

The City of Barrie and Simcoe County are trying extremely hard to ensure poor residents never get fed.
